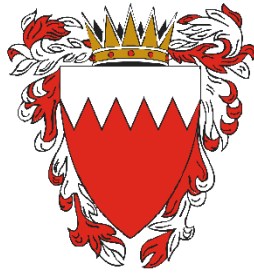

Dr Alkoheji is a Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon with Upper Limb Sub-speciality expertise. He gained his medical degree the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland in 2006. Following an internship at Beaumont Hospital in Dublin, he moved back to Bahrain for a junior residency in Trauma and Orthopaedics at the BDF Hospital, followed by a spell as an upper limb fellow at University College Hospital in London.

He moved for his registrar training years to King's College Hospital, obtaining his Fellowship of the RCS of England in Trauma and in 2017. During this period (in March 2015) he gave a well-attended talk on his experiences to the Bahrain Society.

A final fellowship was undertaken in 2019 at The Royal London Hospital, and in 2020, Dr. Alkoheji started his full-time private practice in Bahrain.

The ticket price of £10 includes a glass of wine (though the club bar will be open) and there will be an opportunity for dinner afterwards at the club.
